There is also a pancake breakfast beginning at 8:00am in front of the Catholic Church, a Show & Shine and activities for the kids. All activities are held outdoors on the downtown streets of St. Walburg. The Festival Market runs from 9:00am to 4:00pm. A dinner and talent night held at the Elks Hall ends off the day; advance tickets are required for this event by calling 306-248-3353. The Festival draws several thousand attendees so it is a great venue to showcase and sell your products! ## RULES, REGULATIONS, & IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YOU:

- > Space rental is \$50 for approximately 14' along the curb x 10' out into the street.
- > Registrations are taken on a first come, first serve basis. Being a past vendor does not give you preference over new vendors in fairness to all 300+ people who are on the email/mailing list, all registrations are taken on a first come, first serve basis. Deadline for registration is August 20, 2019, if all spaces have been filled then you will be placed on a waitlist. All entries must be prepaid at the time of registration. Please make cheque payable to "St. Walburg Chamber of Commerce".
- Confirmation of whether you are an accepted vendor or are on the waitlist will be mailed or emailed to you as soon as we get a chance to process the applications.
- ▶ If you have to cancel after you have been accepted: Cancellations will be accepted if you cancel before August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Cancellations received from August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019 onward will not be refunded.
- If you wish to have a table provided for you, there is an extra charge of \$25.00/table, (Maximum 2 tables/space). Please indicate on the application form if you want a table. TABLES WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE ON BLUEBERRY FEST DAY.
- The charge for electricity is \$20.00. There are a limited number of spaces available with electricity. If you reserve more than 1 space, the \$20 for electricity is only charged once. You are welcome to bring your own generator if you wish but please be sure that is it a quiet generator. We have had complaints about noisy and smelly generators so please be sure if you bring your own that it is in very good working condition.
- ➤ We recommend sun shelters, market umbrellas, or something similar to cover your display. These must be anchored down with sand bags, kitty litter bags, etc. Nailing into pavement is prohibited. We do not supply chairs.
- You will find the "Vendor's Entrance" on First Avenue just west of the Tempo Gas Station. Please note there is only one entrance. We will be available at approximately 7:00 a.m. to show you to your allotted space. Please do not ask in advance what space number you have you will be informed of your space number when you come to the entrance on Saturday morning.
- > When setting up, all vehicles must be off the street by 8:30am. You can start selling at 9:00am.
- Designated parking area for vendors to park in after you have unloaded your products is located on the grassy area just across the alley behind the former CIBC bank and the Legion. You will be issued a parking pass when you arrive, please place it on your windshield so that you can access this parking area.
